Position Title:	Water System Operator (Entry Level to Well-Experienced Invited to Apply)
Job Description:	Performs a variety of duties related to the construction and maintenance of the District's water distribution infrastructure and equipment.
Minimum Qualifications:	Graduation from high school or equivalent.
Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:	Some knowledge of hazards and precautions associated with trench work; industry safety standards and regulations; operation of pumps, equipment; basic hand and power tools; skill in the operation of heavy mechanized equipment as required by the position; i.e., excavation equipment, pumps, generators, air compressors, crane and computer helpful. Ability to adapt to emergency or unusual situations; tolerate weather extremes in the workplace; communicate effectively; perform strenuous manual labor; develop working relationships with supervisors, co-workers and the public; able to lift 70 lbs.
